

Final Placements for 2016-18 batch

The 2016-18 batch comprised of 19 students with an average work experience of 4 years (before joining the institute). The final placement witnessed a trend similar to last year where consulting firms turned up with maximum offers.

Considering the diversity of profiles offered, the students have received offers from consulting firms (**EY, KPMG, PwC, RTI**), banking sector (**IndusInd Bank**), energy sector (**Fortum**), fast moving electric goods sector (**Havells**). Education firms such as **TIME and Edureka** and construction firm such as **ACC** also hired students of the programme. Other companies which participated in the placement process include **Tata Strive, Clinton Health Access Initiative, United Health Group, Wipro Sustainability program, UMTC, Nanomembrane, SmartOwner, SkillPanther, Tresvista**.

Considering the percentage distribution of sectors/consulting in terms of offers, maximum offers were made by the consulting firms (60%), followed by energy and electric sector (13%); education sector (13%) and construction and banking (7% each).

Designations offered include: Senior Consultant, Consultant, Senior Associate, Manager - Impact Investing, Manager - Corporate Communication and Sustainability, Product Manager, Product Head, Lead-Business Development among others
